1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority is the the District Committee of the ISCYRA in conjunction with the Club Nautique de Nice
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3 National prescriptions for foreign competitors are defined in joined appendix named "appendix for foreign prescriptions" Insert any document name and where it is available that will govern the event here. See the definition of Rule (g).
- 1.4 STCR 31.1.3 will not apply, no weight checks are planned
- 1.5 [The following prescriptions of the french national authority will apply: [FOR EVENTS EXPECTING OUT OF NATIONAL AUTHORITY COMPETITORS, EFFECTIVE MNA PRESCRIPTIONS MUST BE LISTED AND REPRINTED AS AN ADDENDUM TO THE NoR]
- 1.6 [INSERT ANY APPENDICES (e.g. Appendix P or T) will apply. {If Appendix P applies, ISCYRA policy is to delete P2.2 and P2.3}(The full Appendix T is useful if the resources are available. If not, then T1 only offers post-race penalty acceptance without enduring a hearing.)
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code) as modified by the Advertising FFVoile Code, boats shall display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open for all Star boats in conformity with Star Class rules (STCR) 21, 26, 29, 30.

3.2. Admissible boats can be registered by completing the entry form and send it to

Competitors (each crew member) living in France shall present at the registration:

- The annual valid and signed FFVoile's licence with health certificate and a parents' permission for the minors,
- The certification of France Star Class membership for skippers only
- The measurement form of the boat and rating certificate,
- A valid authorization of advertising on boat if necessary

Foreign competitors who haven't got a French licence shall justify their membership of an ISAF Member national authority.

No weight restriction for the Xmas regatta

4. REGISTRATION FEES

Before December 2nd : 250 Euros

After December 2nd : 300Euros

5. RACES AND EVENTS SCHEDULE

5.1. Registration : December 27th = 10am to 1pm and 2pm to 5.30pm

5.2 Craning :

- December 27th = From 10AM to 1PM and from 2PM to 5.30PM

- December 30th (end of the regatta) = From 11.00 AM to 2PM. A second crane might be ordered by CNN if necessary

Warning : No craning possible before and after this dates and hours

5.2. RACES

To make sure we can run two races in the morning, we go starting this year at 8:45 am

December 30 **8:45** AM first warning signal

5.3 DYNAMIC MARKS

Traditional marks will be replaced by new self-positioning geostationary dynamic marks to lay the course. See details in appendix 2.

5.4 SOCIAL EVENTS

December 27th : 6PM to 7.30PM : welcome party, open bar (beer) at the Club House

December 28th : Free evening

December 29th : 8 PM Offered dinner for skippers and crews **with Tombola**

December 30th about 2PM, prize giving ceremony

After races BBQ & Beer

After racing BBQ barbecue will be proposed on your way out of the boat at the dock on Dec 28th and 29th. Free for sailors, 20€ for your relatives.

5.5 VENUE / PARKING / CRANING ZONES

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions and possible appendix will be available when registration is confirmed on December 27th.

7. COURSES

Courses will be sausage or triangle, accordingly to STCR prescriptions.

8. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the Club Nautique de Nice

9. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats could not be hauled from 27 dec 6PM to 30 dec 11am. Boats shall be hauled out during the regatta only to repair damages and only in the Club Nautique de Nice crane. With and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.

10. NUMBER OF RACES

10.1. Three races are required to be completed to validate the regatta.

10.2. (a) When 3 or fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 4 races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. PRIZES

Skippers will be rewarded as follows

- 1st
- 2nd
- 3rd
- 4th
- 5th
- First woman
- Youngest skipper of the regatta
- 1st Exalted Grand Master (more than 70 years old)
- 1st Grand Master (more than 60 years old)
- 1st Master (more than 50 years)
- 1st junior (under 25 years old)

12. FRENCH CHAMPIONSHIP OPEN AWARD

The title of "CHAMPION DE FRANCE 2021" will be awarded to the winner of the regatta regardless of his nationality. The second will receive a silver medal and the third will receive a bronze medal.

13. 9th DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP AWARD

The blue Star title will be awarded to the best placed competitor belonging to the 9th district of ISCYRA.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. RESPONSIBILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Decision to race or to continue racing is their own responsibility. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta

16. AUTHORIZATION TO USE NAME AND LOOK

Taking part in this race, the competitor gives the organization and the race's sponsors authority to use and show, static or moving photos, films or TV recording and all sorts of duplication of himself during all the regatta. He also gives authority to use, without royalties, his own image on all materials of such event.

17. INSURANCE

Each foreign competitor who hasn't a FFVoile licence shall present a certificate of third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1500 000 euros.

18. "PLAN VIGIPIRATE " = HARBOR SECURITY RULES

Each Car and trailer have to be registered with their numberplate. Each competitor and crews will have to wear a bracelet of the regatta to enter in the trailers area. Be aware that security teams can carry out body searches.

APPENDIX TO FEDERAL PRESCRIPTIONS

FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2009 – 2012

Applying to foreign competitors

RRS 64.3 (*) :

Jury may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a measurement protest.

RRS 68 (*) :

Any claim for damages arising from an incident involving a boat bound by the RRS shall be subject to the appropriate courts and will not be considered by the jury.

RRS 70. 5 (*) :

In such circumstances, the written approval of the FFVoile shall be received before publishing the notice of race and shall be posted on the official notice board during the competition.

RCV 86.3 (*) :

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1 in order to develop or test new rules shall beforehand submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the regatta. The authorization of the FFVoile shall be mentioned in the notice of race, in the sailing instructions, and shall be posted on the official notice board during the regatta.

RRS 88 (*) :

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall be neither changed nor deleted in the sailing instructions, except for competitions for which an international jury has been appointed. In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall be neither changed nor deleted in the sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website www.ffvoile.org, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

RRS 91 (*) :

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the FFVoile. Such notice of approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
